- II. Approval of Minutes. September 2 & 29, 2021.

Motion: Carlos Garcia Jr, made a motion to Approve Minutes as submitted. Pioquinto Garza seconds the motion. All Board Members present in favor, Motion carried.

- V. New Business
 - 1. Consideration of letter from Semitropic Water Storage District regarding potential reduction in water availability to the Lost Hills Utility District

It appears Semitropic is one of the most over drafted water districts, and for that reason they are cutting off all of the farmers back on their water usage, the District does not farm so we hope we can negotiate with Semitropic the terms of the District's water entitlement. To Assist with those efforts the District has hired Attorney Robert Kuhs who specializes in that area and we also have been offered the assistance from Wonderful's legal team to help with those negotiations.

2. Consideration of suspension of the following will serve letters and annexations:

Manuel Cantu with the Wonderful Company was present to support the updated will serve letter request for the 21 housing project. He completely understands the difficult situation with the water reduction notice from Semitropic and is here's to reinstate that Wonderful has offered their legal team to assist the District in the negotiations regarding this issue as well as the negotiations with Caltrans regarding the sewer relocations project. Tom and Ana are already in contact with Wonderful's legal team discussing about both issues.

At this point we cannot guarantee we will have water to serve any new customers. Daisy Garcia seconds the motion. All Board Members present in favor, Motion carried.

3. Consideration of revised conditional will serve letter

Wonderful has requested an updated will serve letter for the 550 acre feet project for which they would be providing the water to serve their project. The revised letter wills state the same terms but

under a different format in which the District will review the circumstances if and when the development is approved by the county and that if the development exceeds the District's capacity that the applicant will need to provide the water from another source.

Motion: Amanda Rollin made a motion to authorize Tom Schroeter accept the revisions with the changes requested. Carlos Garcia Jr., seconds the motion. Motion carried.

Motion: Pioquinto Garcia made a motion to Approve Cannon's Amendment to Agreement for the Waterline Relocation Project which is funded by Caltrans. Carlos Garcia seconds the motion. All Board Members present in favor, Motion carried.

(b) GEI pre-application for Well No. 3 Project and change order No. 1

Amando Garza - Well No.3 bids came back so expensive that we are reducing the cost to match the available grant 1.2Million. **Motion:** Carlos Garcia Jr., made a motion to Approve Change Order No.1 to reduce the cost. Amanda Rollin seconds the motion. All Board Members present in favor, Motion carried.

(c) Report from Cannon on corrosion inhibitor

State wants us to retain the injection of the Sodium Hydroxide to keep the PH up, and has given the green light for the corrosion inhibitor.

Amando- we are getting the DWR permit and we will be getting in that area where some of the sewer lines will need to be relocated since there in the way, but we can call special meeting once we get the agreement from Caltrans, so the Board can consider the options.
